SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 576, L.D. 781, Bill, "An Act Protecting a Citizen's Right of Petition under the Constitution"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Judicial Department will incur some additional costs to hear certain cases on an expedited basis. Since the number of these cases is expected to be minimal, these additional costs can be absorbed within the existing budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.

The Department of the Attorney General will also incur additional costs to provide legal services in certain circumstances. Because this intervention by the Attorney General is discretionary, these costs can be absorbed within that department's existing budgeted resources.
