#### STATEMENT OF FACT

- 4 Part A of this amendment makes current services allocations from the Highway Fund.
- Part B makes allocations and deallocations from the Highway 8 Fund representing reduction proposals and increased program requirements.

Part C makes allocations from the Highway Fund for approved reclassifications and range changes. 12

- 14 Part D makes deallocations from the elimination of vacant positions at the Department of Transportation. These savings are allocated to the Highway Resurfacing Capital Program. 16
- Part E makes deallocations resulting from the elimination of 18 48 seasonal positions at the Department of Transportation. These savings are allocated to the Highway Resurfacing Capital Program. 20
- Part F makes allocations from the Highway Fund for 2 Revenue 22 Agent positions. This Part also transfers 6 seasonal positions 24 from the Highway and Bridge Improvement account to the Administration and Planning account.
- Part G makes allocations and deallocations from the Federal Expenditure Fund. 28
- 30 Part H makes deallocations from the Transportation Safety Fund.
- Part I makes deallocations from the Motor Transport Services Program of the Highway Garage Fund. 34
- Part J makes additional allocations from the Highway Fund 36 for the Highway Resurfacing Capital Program.
