18 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 289, L.D. 787, Bill, "An
20 Act to Expand the Membership of the State Employee Health
22 Commission"

24 Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and
inserting in its place the following:

26 'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §285-A, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1993, c. 68,
28 §1, is further amended to read:

30 **2. Membership.** The State Employee Health Commission
consists of ~~16~~ 18 labor and management members as follows:

32 A. One labor member from each bargaining unit recognized
34 under Title 26, chapter 9-B, appointed by the employee
organization certified to represent the unit;

36 B. One labor member from the largest bargaining unit
38 recognized under Title 26, chapter 14, appointed by the
employee organization authorized to represent the unit;

40 C. One labor member appointed by the retiree chapters of
42 the Maine State Employees Association;

44 D. Four management members appointed by the Commissioner of
Administrative and Financial Services;

46 E. One management member appointed by the Court
48 Administrators;

50 F. The Executive Director of Health Insurance, ex officio;
and

2 G. One member representing retirees appointed by the Maine Association of Retirees;

4 H. One labor member from the Maine Technical College System
6 faculty or administrative unit, appointed by the employee
organization authorized to represent the units; and

8 I. One management member from the Maine Technical College
10 System appointed by the President of the Maine Technical
College System.

12 All appointed or elected members serve at the pleasure of their
14 appointing or electing authorities.'

16 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

18 **FISCAL NOTE**

20 The minor additional costs associated with increasing the
22 membership of the State Employee Health Commission can be
absorbed by the commission utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

24 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

26 This amendment adds a labor and a management member from the
28 Maine Technical College System to the State Employee Health
Commission.

30 This amendment also adds a fiscal note.
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
