Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Membership. consists of 16 17 labor and management members as follows: 8 One labor member from each bargaining unit recognized Α. under Title 26, chapter 9-B, appointed by the employee 10 organization certified to represent the unit; 12 One labor member from the largest bargaining unit Β. recognized under Title 26, chapter 14, appointed by the 14 employee organization authorized to represent the unit; 16 с. One labor member appointed by the retiree chapters of the Maine State Employees Association; 18Four management members appointed by the Commissioner of 20 D. Administrative and Financial Services; 22 Ε. management appointed Court One member by the Administrators: 24 26 F. The Executive Director of Health Insurance, ex officio; and 28 One member representing retirees appointed by the Maine G. 30 Association of Retirees+; and H. One labor member from the Maine Technical College System 32 faculty or administrative unit, appointed by the employee 34 organization authorized to represent the units. All appointed or elected members serve at the pleasure of their 36 appointing or electing authorities. 38 STATEMENT OF FACT 40 42 This bill adds a member of the Maine Technical College System faculty or administration to the State Employee Health Commission. 44
