## An Act to Require Firearm Hunters to Wear Blaze Orange.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§12, as repealed and replaced by PL 4 1991, c. 824, Pt. A, §21, is amended to read: Hunting without hunter orange clothing. A person is 6 12. guilty of hunting without hunter orange clothing if that person hunts with firearms during the open firearm any season on deer 8 and fails to wear 2 articles of solid-colored hunter orange 10 clothing that are in good, serviceable condition and visible from all sides, except that-persons-hunting-waterfowl-from-a-boat-or 12 blind--or--in-conjunction--with--waterfewl--decoys-need-net--wear hunter--orange--elothing as provided in this subsection. One 14 article of clothing must be a hat. The other article of clothing must cover a major portion of the torso, such as a jacket, vest, The presence of a decal on an article of 16 coat or poncho. clothing that is otherwise solid-colored hunter orange does not disgualify that article of clothing from satisfying the 18 requirements of this subsection. This subsection does not apply 20 to: 22 A. A person hunting waterfowl from a boat or blind or in conjunction with waterfowl decoys; 24 B. A person hunting bear with bait; 26 C. A person hunting wild turkeys; or 28 D. A person hunting coyotes and foxes outside the regular 30 firearms season on deer. 32 STATEMENT OF FACT 34 Current law requires that individuals hunting with firearms 36 during deer season wear hunter orange clothing. This bill extends that requirement for any season, but exempts hunters 38 participating in certain types of hunting.
