

2 **Sec. 1. Department of Administrative and Financial Services to limit**
3 **administrative costs. Resolved:** That the Department of
4 Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of the Budget shall
5 define the administrative costs of each state agency and set
6 department targets for administrative costs that establish a
7 percentage limit not to exceed 10% for each department. The
8 department shall report its findings to the Joint Standing
9 Committee on Appropriation and Financial Affairs no later than
10 December 1, 1995.

11 Beginning on July 1, 1996, the department shall apply its
12 findings for a maximum administrative cost to the Department of
13 Human Services and the Department of Education and on or before
14 July 1, 1997 establish the administrative cost limitations in all
15 state agencies.

STATEMENT OF FACT

21 This resolve directs the Department of Administrative and
22 Financial Services to establish a limit on administrative costs
23 not to exceed 10% and apply the limits to the Department of Human
24 Services and the Department of Education beginning in fiscal year
25 1995-96 and extend the limitation to all departments beginning in
26 fiscal year 1996-97.
