2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA c. 709, sub-c. IV-B** is enacted to read:

6 **SUBCHAPTER IV-B**

8 **COYOTE BOUNTY**

10 **§7522. Coyote bounty**

12 There is a bounty of \$15 for every coyote that is killed
14 within the State in accordance with rules established by the
16 commissioner. The rules must establish procedures for certifying
18 the killing of a coyote and claiming the bounty. The department
20 shall use existing funds appropriated to the Bureau of Resource
Management for animal damage control to fund the coyote bounty.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This bill establishes a \$15 bounty on coyotes.
