20	spend on their children that has been adopted by the Department of Human Services under former section 303-A <u>303-B</u> .
22	Sec. 3. Effective date. That section of this Act that amends
24	the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 19, section 311, subsection 3 takes effect January 1, 1996.
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28	STATEMENT OF FACT
30	This bill requires the Department of Human Services to adopt rules establishing a child support table that incorporates the
32	Connecticut Child Support and Arrearage Guidelines adopted by the Connecticut Commission for Child Support Guidelines in 1994. The
34	schedule must be adopted by January 1, 1996. The definition of "child support table" is amended to reflect the change, effective
36	January 1, 1996.

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
