## STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment makes ring-size limits for drags in South Bay in Eastport apply to all drags. The bill applied ring-size limits to rock drags.

The amendment also limits drags to a total of 8 rings deep, with the ring size limited to the legal size that applies to either a state license or federal permit, depending on which license a person holds.
