Amend the amendment in section 9 in that part designated "~~S1556.~~" in the first paragraph by striking out all of the last sentence (page 12, lines 6 to 9 in amendment)

This amendment removes language that expressly prohibits municipalities from enacting ordinances and regulations regarding tobacco displays, product placement and the time of tobacco product sales.
