28	Further amend the resolution by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
30	FISCAL NOTE

34	The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 117th
36	Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional
38	referendum costs an additional \$7,000.
40	If enacted by the voters, beginning in fiscal year 1996-97 General Fund expenditures will be limited by a formula prescribed
42	by the Legislature; a reserve fund will be created to receive 75% of excess revenues to be used only in years of revenue
44	shortfalls; and 25% of excess revenues would be placed in the Property Tax Relief Fund, established in the Maine Revised
46	Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5683.'
