2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7102-A, sub-§6, ¶C**, as corrected by RR 1993,
c. 1, §35, is amended by repealing subparagraph 3.

6 **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7102-A, sub-§6, ¶D** is enacted to read:

8 D. Notwithstanding section 7458, subsections 1 and 2, a
10 person who has taken a deer with bow and arrow during the
12 special open season for archery hunting may hunt for and
14 kill a 2nd deer with a firearm during the firearm season for
16 deer if that person pays an additional fee of \$7.50. This
18 paragraph is repealed October 15, 1997.

20 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

22 This bill allows a person who has killed a deer during the
special archery season for deer to hunt and kill a 2nd deer with
a firearm during the regular firearm season for deer if that
person pays an additional fee of \$7.50.
