Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §6114 is enacted to read:

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§6114. Private fire protection charges

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Notwithstanding any other provision of this Title, a rate filed by a water utility for private fire protection service may not be found to be unjust or unreasonable on the ground that the rate filed by the utility seeks to recover a portion of the total cost of the water utility's backup facilities, including all costs associated with the utility's transmission and distribution mains, storage facilities, pumps and other facilities. Any provision of any rule adopted by the commission that is inconsistent with this section is void and of no effect.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill allows water utilities to establish rates for private fire protection that include recovery for a portion of the costs of the utilities' backup facilities, including mains, storage facilities and pumps.
