HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 651, L.D. 874, Bill, "An Act to Establish Tuition Rates for the Unorganized Territory Schools Based on a State Average"


Amend the amendment in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 45 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "year" the following: 'and is limited to an increase for the 1995-96 school year not to exceed 5% of the amount established in 1994-95'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment, in establishing a tuition range for the 1995-96 school year, will decrease tuition revenue that supports the Edmunds Consolidated School by approximately \$31,000 in fiscal year 1995-96. Sufficient resources to offset the lost revenue are available within the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment establishes a per student tuition charge for students from the Town of Dennysville attending the Edmunds School for the 1995-96 school year and limits any increase in the tuition charge to no more than 5% over the tuition charge for the 1994-95 school year.
