Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1304, sub-§17 is enacted to read:

17. Storage of wood wastes. The board shall adopt rules relating to the storage of wood wastes, including without limitation, the establishment of time limits for the uncovered storage of processed wood wastes that take into account the economic impact of a temporary shutdown of a biomass generator or other similar consumers of those wastes. The board shall provide for a waiver of an established time limit on a case-by-case basis, establish criteria for granting such a waiver and provide for alternative storage methods in the event of a temporary shutdown.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the Board of Environmental Protection to adopt rules relating to the storage of wood wastes, including rules establishing time limits for the uncovered storage of processed wood wastes and rules providing for alternative storage methods in the event of a temporary shutdown of a biomass generator.
