General Fund \$5,400

The amendment eliminates the per diem authorization for legislative members of the Study Commission on Workers' Compensation Laws Relating to Small Business, reducing the amount of the General Fund appropriation required by \$2,310, from \$7,710 to \$5,400 in fiscal year 1996-97.
