HOUSE AMENDMENT " $\mathcal{B}$ " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 664, L.D. 887, Bill, "An Act to Encourage Job Creation by Exempting Small Businesses from the Current Workers' Compensation System"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of subsections 7 and 8 and inserting in their place the following:

'7. Three members of the Joint Standing Committee on Banking and Insurance: one member appointed by the President of the Senate, one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one member jointly appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives may consider recommendations made by the chairs of the Joint Standing Committee on Banking and Insurance; and

8. Three members of the Joint Standing Committee on Labor: 32 one member appointed by the President of the Senate, one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one 34 member jointly appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House. The President of the Senate and the 36 Speaker of theHouse of Representatives may consider recommendations made by the chairs of the Joint Standing 38 Committee on Labor; and be it further'
