'7. Three members of the Joint Standing Committee on Banking and Insurance: one member appointed by the President of the Senate, one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one member jointly appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives may consider recommendations made by the chairs of the Joint Standing Committee on Banking and Insurance; and

Three members of the Joint Standing Committee on Labor: one member appointed by the President of the Senate, one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one member jointly appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House. 
