16	B. The local share of the allocation for program costs is the actual local program costs in the base year adjusted and bus purchase costs in the year priertetheyear of

24	(1) The program millage limit is the mills derived by dividing 40% of the actual local program costs adjusted

30	(2) The local share percentage of program costs is the proportion that the local share of the allocation for program cost is to the maximum program cost allocation.
32	The state share percentage of program costs is the proportion that the state share of the allocation for

38	STATEMENT OF FACT
40	This bill provides school administrative units with state subsidy for the purchase of a school bus in the year in which the
42	bus is purchased. Current law provides state subsidy in the year

following the year of purchase.
