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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause. The amendment also directs the Bureau of Insurance to report on the existing mandates and the mandates proposed during the First Regular Session of the 117th Legislature to develop a comparable list of mandates for health maintenance organizations. The report date has also been amended from May 1, 1995 to January 1, 1996.
