October 1, 1995. One Special Investigator position is effective July 1, 1996 to continue the position funded by federal funds for one year.

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It also includes General Fund appropriations of \$175,332 and \$238,122 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, for 4.5 positions and related expenses to assist the Maine Human Rights Commission in the enforcement of the Maine Human Rights Act.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment replaces the bill. It reduces the General Fund appropriation for one research assistant and some additional expenses in the Department of the Attorney General in anticipation of 2 federal grants. The federal grant money is allocated to the Department of the Attorney General.

This amendment also reduces the appropriation to the Maine Human Rights Commission to restore a total of 2 1/2 field investigator positions, one staff attorney position and one clerk typist III position.
