Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §563-A, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

 9. Underground oil storage tanks with capacity not
exceeding 1,000 gallons. The requirements of subsection 1 do not apply to an underground oil storage tank with a capacity not
exceeding 1,000 gallons that is used exclusively by a homeowner for the storage of fuel oil and that meets environmental
monitoring and other leak detection procedures approved by the commissioner.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts underground oil storage tanks with a 18 capacity not exceeding 1,000 gallons that are used by a homeowner for the storage of fuel from the nonconforming underground oil 20 storage tank removal deadlines.
