### **An Act Allowing Homeowners to Maintain Underground Oil Tanks.**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §563-A, sub-§9** is enacted to read:

6 9. Underground oil storage tanks with capacity not  
8 exceeding 1,000 gallons. The requirements of subsection 1 do not  
10 apply to an underground oil storage tank with a capacity not  
12 exceeding 1,000 gallons that is used exclusively by a homeowner  
14 for the storage of fuel oil and that meets environmental  
16 monitoring and other leak detection procedures approved by the  
18 commissioner.

### 16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill exempts underground oil storage tanks with a  
20 capacity not exceeding 1,000 gallons that are used by a homeowner  
for the storage of fuel from the nonconforming underground oil  
storage tank removal deadlines.
