COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 673, L.D. 924, Bill, "An Act to Repeal Laws Regarding Minimum Wages on Construction Projects"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 11 the following:

'Sec. 12. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Deappropriates funds from savings realized by eliminating the requirement of preparing and distributing certain surveys.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund (\$3,094) (\$4,220)

The repeal of certain minimum wage requirements that include the preparation and distribution of a survey will result in General Fund savings to the Department of Labor of \$3,094 and \$4,220 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively. These amounts are deappropriated from the Bureau of Labor Standards - Regulation and Enforcement program.

This repeal may also result in savings to state departments and agencies from lower construction contract amounts. The precise amount of any savings can not be determined at this time.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
