

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2054, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

B. Only a police vehicle may be equipped with a device that provides for alternate flashing of the vehicle's brake or rear directional lights and back-up lights or strobe lights behind the rear brake lenses.

Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2076, sub-§3, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

C. A motor vehicle that, in accordance with 49 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 172, Subpart F, is required to be marked or placarded ~~with one of the following markings:~~

- {1}--Explosives-A;
- {2}--Explosives-B;
- {3}--Poison-gas;
- {4}--Flammable-solid-W;
- {5}--Radioactive;
- {6}--Flammable;
- {7}--Blasting-agent;
- {8}--Nonflammable-gas;
- {9}--Chlorine;
- {10}--Poison;
- {11}--Oxygen;
- {12}--Flammable-gas;
- {13}--Combustible;
- {14}--Flammable-solid;
