30	The estimated cost of sending this constitutional amendment out to referendum will vary according to the total number of
32	referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 117th Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one
34	to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

38	If approved by the voters, this constitutional amendment will prevent the State from reducing benefits for state employees or teachers. Retirement benefit reductions would only be allowed
40	for employees hired after the effective date of this amendment.
