COMMITTEE OF CONFERENCE AMENDMENT " C " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 691, L.D. 942, Bill, "An Act to Improve Highway Signing Information"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§1912-B." in the first paragraph by inserting after the first sentence the following new sentences: 'A logo sign may not be larger than existing service information signs permitted on the interstate highway. More than one sign per exit is prohibited. A logo sign may include logos for tourist attractions, such as museums or other locations of public interest. To the fullest extent possible, the commissioner shall ensure that each logo sign include at least one logo for gas, one logo for food and one logo for lodging.'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§1912-B." by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph (page 1, lines 41 to 43 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'The commissioner, with the advice of the Travel Information Advisory Council, shall adopt rules to implement this section. Those rules may not be adopted until March 15, 1996. The commissioner shall report to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation in January 1996 on the development of those rules.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment limits logo and service signing along the interstate to one sign per exit and prohibits the new logo signs from being any larger than existing service signs. The amendment also clarifies that logo signs may include logos for tourist attractions such as museums or other locations of public interest.
