\$1067. Rulemaking

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The board may adopt rules in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act that are necessary for the implementation of this chapter. The rules may include, but are not limited to, requirements for licensure, interviews for licensing and renewal, continuing education, inactive licensure status and fees for providing a list of addresses of licensed professionals upon request.

§1068. Liaison

On or before August 1st of each year, the board shall submit to the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation, for the preceding fiscal year ending June 30th, its annual report of its operations and financial position, with comments and recommendations the board considers essential.

The commissioner shall act as a liaison between the board and the Governor.

§1100-A. Definition

Duties of dental auxiliaries other than dental hygienists must be defined and governed by the rules of the Board of Dental Examiners. Dental auxiliaries include, but are not limited to, dental hygienists, dental assistants, and dental laboratory technicians and-denturists.

18	This bill establishes the Board of Denturists as the regulatory board that has jurisdiction over the licensing of

22	on the same premises and eliminates language establishing the liability of the supervising dentist for a denturist's actions.
