28	10. Advanced practice registered nurse. An "advanced
30	practice registered nurse" is a registered professional nurse who, on the basis of advanced, specialized education and certification credentials, is prepared to provide health care
32	services. The practice builds on previous knowledge and skill and utilizes in-depth knowledge of physical assessment and
34	management of illnesses or conditions within the advanced practice registered nurse's area of practice. "Advanced practice
36	registered nurse" includes a certified nurse practitioner, a certified nurse midwife, a certified psychiatric clinical nurse
38	specialist, a certified clinical nurse specialist and a certified nurse anesthetist who are approved by the board.
40	A. An advanced practice registered nurse must:
42	(1) Hold a current license to practice as a registered
44	professional nurse in this State;
46	(2) Have completed a formal education program in advanced nursing or nurse midwifery, or both, in the
48	speciality area of practice that is acceptable to the board; and
50	(3) Hold a current certification credential for
52	advanced nursing practice from a national certifying

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<u>body whose certification program is acceptable to the board.</u>

4 The board shall adopt rules defining the appropriate standards of practice and requirements for authorization to 6 practice under this subsection.

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- 8 <u>A registered nurse approved and licensed to practice, in</u> accordance with former section 2102, subsection 2, paragraph 10 <u>B, prior to the effective date of this subsection is deemed</u> approved as an advanced practice registered nurse.
- B. A person who qualifies under this subsection and whose14application for advanced practice registered nurse
designation has been approved by the board is designated an16advanced practice registered nurse. "A.P.R.N." is the
abbreviation for the title of "advanced practice registered18nurse." The approved applicant may use the title "A.P.R.N."
and the title or abbreviation designated by the national20certifying body.
- 22 <u>C. Temporary approval to practice as an advanced practice</u> registered nurse may be granted by the board:
- (1) For a period of 90 days to an applicant who is currently approved to practice as an advanced practice registered nurse in another jurisdiction with requirements at least equivalent to those of this State; or
- (2) To an applicant who meets the requirements of

 qualifies for and takes the next available
 34 certification exam.
- 36 <u>D. Advanced practice registered nurse designation may be</u> terminated by the board when the advanced practice

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	F. The Joint Practice Council on Advanced Practice

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	(1) The Joint Practice Council on Advanced Practice
6	Registered Nurses consists of 4 members, including 2
	<u>members from the State Board of Nursing, one member</u>
8	from the Board of Licensure in Medicine and one member
	from the Board of Osteopathic Licensure. Each board
10	shall appoint its representatives to serve terms at the
	discretion of the appointing board. In adopting rules
12	of the council, members must be guided by the best
	interests of the general public and not the interests
14	of their own professions.
16	The State Board of Nursing shall designate one of its
	appointees as the first chair of the council, who shall
18	call the first meeting of the council. The position of
	<u>chair must be rotated among members at intervals</u>
20	determined by the council.
22	(2) The council shall make recommendations to the
	appropriate boards on matters of mutual concern. The
24	duties of the council are advisory in nature.
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	STATEMENT OF FACT
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	This bill allows certain registered nurses to be designated
30	as advanced practice registered nurses authorized to prescribe
	certain drugs and devices.

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This bill also establishes the Joint Practice Council on 34 Advanced Practice Registered Nurses.
