Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §8065 is enacted to read:
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§8065. Agency fees
Any fee established by agency rule before July 1, 1996 is
repealed on that date unless the amount of that fee has been
approved by act of the Legislature. After July 1, 1996, an
agency may not charge a fee unless the amount of that fee has
been approved by act of the Legislature.
STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill sunsets agency fees on July 1, 1996 unless the
amounts of those fees have been approved by act of the
Legislature. After that date, the amounts of all fees must be
approved by the Legislature.
