## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities and Energy and makes certain changes to clarify the language of the bill. The amendment strikes the provision of the bill requiring Public Utilities Commission commissioners to be of good character, compassionate and possess common sense. The amendment changes the portion of the bill requiring financial disclosures by Public Utilities Commission commissioners to require disclosures only of sources of income from which the commissioners receive more than \$1,000.
