SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 716, L.D. 973, Bill, "An Act to Improve Maine Students' Preparedness for the Global Economy by Enhancing Opportunities for Global Education"

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$5,000

The Department of Education and the Department of Economic and Community Development will incur some minor additional costs to provide assistance to the Maine Committee for Global and Geographic Education. These costs can be absorbed within the departments' existing budgeted resources.

The minor additional costs to participate on the committee can be absorbed within the existing budgeted resources of the member state departments and agencies.

The bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$5,000 in fiscal year 1995-96 to the committee to provide grants to public schools.'

This amendment reduces the amount of General Fund appropriations provided for grants to \$5,000 in fiscal year 1995-96.
