2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA, §1073, sub-§1-A** is enacted to read:

6 **1-A. Golf club auxiliary licenses.** The commission may
8 issue an auxiliary license under this section for the sale of
10 spirits, wine and malt liquor at additional premises operated by
12 a golf club that is licensed under subsection 1. The commission
14 may not charge for auxiliary licenses.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill provides for the issuance of auxiliary licenses
for the sale of spirits, wine and malt liquor at golf clubs.
