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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill amended the specific criteria under which a teacher, education specialist or administrator could seek a certification waiver from the Commissioner of Education.

This amendment clarifies that a waiver granted to an individual who receives allegedly inaccurate, incomplete or untimely information must be for a period of time sufficient to allow the individual to complete certification requirements.

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This amendment also identifies alternative methods by which an individual may demonstrate compliance with certification requirements and requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules to further develop those methods.
