5. Sue for compensatory fee; application. A person who sues an owner for a compensatory fee to which the person is not entitled is liable to the owner for attorney's fees and any other related costs of litigation. This subsection applies to any suit that was filed on or after January 1, 1994.

This bill allows an owner of recovered property who is wrongfully sued for a compensatory fee to be reimbursed for any attorney's fee and other costs of litigation by the person who brought the suit. The bill also makes the provision applicable to suits that were filed on or after January 1, 1994.
