2 **Sec. 1. Hilt's Point. Resolved:** That the cove located halfway
up the St. George River in the Town of St. George and known as
Watts Point is renamed Hilt's Point; and be it further

6 **Sec. 2. Hathorn's Point. Resolved:** That the cove located on
the Town of Cushing side of the St. George River, approximately 2
miles from the mouth of the St. George River, and known as Burton
Point is renamed Hathorn's Point; and be it further

10 **Sec. 3. Gaunt Neck. Resolved:** That the cove on the eastern
shore of the Meduncook River in the Town of Cushing and known as
Bradford Point is renamed Gaunt Neck; and be it further

14 **Sec. 4. Bradford Point. Resolved:** That the cove located in the
Town of Friendship, just north of Garrison Island is officially
named Bradford Point; and be it further

18 **Sec. 5. Resolve 1993, c. 3, repealed. Resolved:** That Resolve 1993,
c. 3 is repealed.
