SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 365, L.D. 991, "Resolve, to Strengthen Fish Hatchery Capacity within the State by Establishing a Partnership between Public and Private Organizations"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 27 to 30 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. Task force. Resolved: That the Fish Hatchery Task Force to Investigate Establishing a Partnership between Public and Private Organizations is created, and in this resolve referred to as "task force," to enter into discussions that include other interested parties to investigate and pursue opportunities for creating a partnership of public and private organizations for the efficient operation of state fishery restoration programs for inland and coastal waters; and be it further

Sec. 2. Task force membership; election of chair. Resolved: That the task force membership consists of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, the Commissioner of Marine Resources, the Commissioner of Environmental Protection, the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, one member of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate, one member of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one member of the public to be appointed by the Governor. The Chair of the Legislative Council shall convene the first meeting. At the first meeting, the task force shall elect a chair from among its members; and be it further

2 **Sec. 3. Meetings; reimbursement. Resolved:** That the task force
3 hold meetings in Augusta to take input from the public, there be
4 public notice of those meetings and that the meetings and task
5 force documents are public proceedings and public records
6 pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 1, section 402.
7 Members are not entitled to receive reimbursement for expenses.
8 Legislative members are not entitled to receive per diem
compensation; and be it further'

10 Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the 2nd line (page
11 1, line 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
12 "commissioners" and inserting in its' place the following: 'task
13 force'

14 Further amend the resolve in section 3 in the first line
15 (page 1, line 43 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
16 "commissioners" and inserting in its place the following: 'task
17 force'

18 Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 3rd
19 indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 32 to 35 in
20 amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

21 'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 4
22 and inserting in its place the following:

23 '**Sec. 4. Report. Resolved:** That the task force shall report
24 its recommendations on these issues and policies to the 117th
25 Legislature by January 1, 1996.'

26 Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 4th
27 indented paragraph after the title the following:

28 'Further amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any
29 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read
30 consecutively.'

32 FISCAL NOTE

33 The amendment eliminates the need for a General Fund
34 appropriation for per diem, expenses, and public hearing costs of
35 the task force.

36 The additional costs to print the report of the task force
37 can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted
38 resources.'


