An Act to Repeal the Salmon Aquaculture Monitoring and Research Fund.

Presented by Senator GOLDTHWAIT of Hancock. Cosponsored by Representatives: BIGL of Bucksport, RICE of South Bristol. **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, the Legislature has repealed the July 1, 1994 sunset date originally established for the Salmon Aquaculture Monitoring and Research Fund; and

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Whereas, the views of the State's finfish aquaculture 10 industry were not adequately taken into account when the sunset date was repealed; and

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Whereas, this Act establishes a new sunset date of July 1, 14 1995, for the fund and requires the finfish aquaculture industry and the Commissioner of Marine Resources to review the adequacy 16 and purposes of the fund, in order to make additional recommendations to the Legislature before that date; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

26 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6078, as amended by PL 1993, c. 562, §2, is 28 repealed.

Sec. 2. Review. The Commissioner of Marine Resources shall review the purposes and adequacy of the Salmon Aquaculture
Monitoring and Research Fund. When conducting this review, the commissioner shall provide an opportunity for comments by the
finfish aquaculture industry. The commissioner shall report the results of this review and make recommendations to the
Legislature by June 15, 1995.

38 Sec. 3. Effective date. That section of this Act that repeals the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6078 takes effect
40 July 1, 1995.

42 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved, except as
44 otherwise indicated.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the Salmon Aquaculture Monitoring and 50 Research Fund on July 1, 1995 and requires the Commissioner of

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Marine Resources to review the purposes and adequacy of the fund and report the results of that review to the Legislature.

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
