Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 16 MRSA $\S614$, sub- $\S1$, first \P , as repealed and replaced by PL 1993, c. 719, $\S7$ and affected by $\S12$, is amended to read:

Limitation on dissemination of intelligence investigative information. Reports or records that contain intelligence and investigative information and that are prepared by, prepared at the direction of or kept in the custody of a local, county or district criminal justice agency; the Bureau of State Police; the Department of the Attorney General; the Maine Drug Enforcement Agency; the Office of State Fire Marshal; the Department of Corrections; er the criminal law enforcement units of the Department of Marine Resources or the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife; or the Department of Conservation, Forest Fire Control Division are confidential and may not disseminated if there is a reasonable possibility that public release or inspection of the reports or records would:
