Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2070, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

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7. **Penalty.** A person who violates the provisions of this section commits a Class D crime.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill changes the penalty for improper passing of a motor vehicle from the penalty for a traffic infraction to the penalty for a Class D crime.

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
