Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §455, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

4. Contribution to the Maine Environmental Trust Fund. In addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fee prescribed by law for the particular class of vehicle registered, the annual contribution for an original issuance of environmental registration plates is \$20, which must be deposited with the Treasurer of State and of which \$10 must be credited to the Maine Environmental Trust Fund established in Title 12, section 7759; \$6 to the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation; and \$4 to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for nongame programs.

Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §455, sub-§4-A is enacted to read:

Motor vehicle registration fee prescribed by law for the particular class of vehicle registration, the contribution for renewal of environmental registration plates is \$10. That fee must be deposited with the Treasurer of State and \$6 credited to the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation and \$4 credited to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for nongame programs.

5. Reimbursement for production and issuance costs. The Treasurer of State shall transfer annually from the Maine Environmental Trust Fund to the Secretary of State \$10 for each set of environmental registration plates originally issued ex

renewed. This transfer is to reimburse the Secretary of State for costs associated with production and issuance of the plates.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill reduces the amount for renewal of the loon plates from \$20 to \$10 and provides that from the original and renewal fees, \$6 is credited to the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation and \$4 is credited to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for nongame programs.
