10	4. Hunting permits. In accordance with the provisions of subsections subsection 1-A and-2-A, the commissioner may issue moose hunting permits and may establish the number of moose
12	hunting permits to be issued for each moose hunting zone. No more than 10% of the moose hunting permits may be issued to
14	nonresident and alien hunters. A person whose application is selected may purchase a moose hunting permit upon presentation of
16	proof that the person possesses:
18	A. A valid Maine hunting license, if the person is a resident of the State; or

22	B. A valid Maine big game hunting license, if the person is a nonresident or alien.
24	The fee for a moose hunting permit is \$25 for 1993, \$27 for 1994, \$28 for 1995 and \$29 for 1996 and every year thereafter for
26	residents and \$200 for 1993, \$202 for 1994, \$203 for 1995 and \$204 for 1996 and every year thereafter for nonresidents and
28	aliens. While hunting moose, each nonresident or alien hunter, both permittee and subpermittee, must be in possession of a valid
30	Maine nonresident or alien big game hunting license, whichever is applicable.
