Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §451, sub-§4, ¶D, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

D. A new registration plate must have:

(1) A white background; and

(2) Identification numbers, letters and the border distinctly navy blue; ~~and.~~

~~(3) -- An illustration of a lobster distinctly lobster red.~~

Sec. 2. Transition. Notwithstanding this Act, the Secretary of State may continue to issue registration plates having a lobster illustration only until the supply of any such plates existing on the effective date of this Act is exhausted.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the Secretary of State to discontinue the issuance of lobster-illustrated registration plates once the current supply is exhausted.
