Sec. 1. Reorganization proposal. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Environmental Protection or the commissioner's designees shall prepare a proposal to abolish the bureau structure currently existing within the department and to reorganize the department along functional lines. The commissioner shall review the functions of the department and the final report issued by the Special Commission on Governmental Restructuring that was issued on December 15, 1991 and prepare a proposal that restructures the functions of the department, resulting in a technical services division, a licensing division, and an enforcement division; and be it further

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall submit a report, together with any necessary implementing legislation to the Legislature no later than December 1, 1996.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve requires the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to prepare a proposal to restructure the department along functional lines, resulting in a technical services division, a licensing division and an enforcement division.
