Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2110 is enacted to read:
§2110. Use of public funds to challenge validity
of a municipal charter
Municipal officers may not spend public funds to challenge
the validity of a municipal charter, any provision of a municipal
charter or any amendment or revision of a municipal charter that
has been adopted under this chapter.
STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill prohibits the use of public funds by municipal
officers to challenge the validity of a municipal charter, any
provision of the charter or any amendment or revision of the charter.
