The amendment also 24 states that any claim against the state or a political subdivision of the State must proceed under the Maine Tort Claims 26 Act. The Maine Tort Claims Act is amended to reflect that the governmental entity's responsibilities are as provided in the

Ice-skating Safety Act. This amendment also adds a fiscal note
