	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §622, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 648, is

6	2. Operator. "Operator" means a private person or entity who owns or controls or who has operational responsibility for an
8	ice-skating rink. An "operator" does not include the State $\Theta_{\mathbf{F}_{\mathbf{A}}}$ a political subdivision of the State <u>or a municipality</u> .

12	STATEMENT OF FACT

	This bill amends the definition of operator so that
16	municipalities are added to the list of operators exempt from liability as long as the ice-skating rink is kept in good
18	condition. Current law provides that an individual may sue the municipality if an injury occurs at an ice-skating rink.
