

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. New 1995 state valuation.** Notwithstanding any other
6 provision in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 36, the 1995
8 valuation for the Town of Searsport, for the purposes of school
appropriations and municipal revenue-sharing funds must be based
on a valuation that values the property of the Department of
Transportation in Sears Island at \$0.

14 This bill requires the Bureau of Taxation to recognize the
valuation of the Department of Transportation's Sears Island
property at \$0 for the State's 1995 valuation.
