

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §106-A** is enacted to read:

6 **§106-A. Surcharge**

8 In addition to any other penalty imposed under this Title, a
10 \$5 surcharge must be imposed on a person who commits a moving
12 violation. The \$5 surcharge must be paid to the law enforcement
14 agency responsible for charging the person with the moving
16 violation.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill imposes a \$5 surcharge on a person who commits a
18 moving violation to be paid to the law enforcement agency
charging the person with the moving violation.
