HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 761, L.D. 1035, "Resolve, to Create the Teacher Retirement Advisory Committee"

Amend the amendment on the 2nd page by striking out all of the 4th and 5th indented paragraphs (page 2, lines 14 to 19 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. 6. Compensation. Resolved:** That members of the committee are not entitled to receive compensation or reimbursement for expenses.' '
